

As much as we love gathering together as a large church family, we are living in a unique time right now giving us opportunities to think outside of the box about how to best support, encourage, and connect with one another. One of the ways "church" looks different now, is that we are relying more heavily on our online presence to communicate with you. We want to share with you ways to connect online, as well as ways to connect on a more personal level.

We are calling our current church model "Church at Home." The church is not a building but rather a body of God's people. Church at Home represents many homes coming together as God's church.

Here are some ways to connect with your SonLight family:

- 1. **Watch the service online.** The SonLight service is available on Facebook or Youtube or our website on Sunday mornings at 10 am. Invite someone over to watch with you. Host a watch party. CDC says less than 10 people gathering so use your discretion.
- 2. **Watch the children's lesson as a family.** Beginning at 9:30 am Sunday morning, you can find a video of the children's story lesson & content for the week on our Facebook page.
- 3. **Watch the daily devotional.** Monday through Friday at 6 pm, keep an eye out for a daily encouragement video. Some of these will be brought to you by our Pastoral staff at SonLight, others by our men's & women's ministry directors.
- 4. **Check out RightNow Media.** Each of our pastors have put together a "watch list" on RightNow Media. RightNow Media is an online video Bible study resource provided free to you. If you don't have an account, contact Sheila@SonLightCommunity.com to sign up.
- 5. **Connect one-on-one**. Invite someone over to watch church together on Sunday morning. Have a meal with someone. If you are uncomfortable having people over right now, find ways to connect by talking on the phone, texting, email, hosting a watch party on social media, etc. Or be sure to connect with those in your home. Pray together. Read the Bible together. Worship through song together.
- 6. **Join A Zoom Group**. We will be starting times that we can pray together, encourage one another, share with one another over video conferencing.
- 7. **We want to hear from you!** How are you doing? Do you want someone to pray with you? Do you have physical needs? What is God doing in your life and through your life during this time? The staff is available by phone during our regular office hours (Monday-Thursday, 8 am 3 pm). We are also available by email. Feel free to comment on our social media pages.
