## Week Seven 2 Timothy 4:1-8

What teaching or preaching is popular in our culture? What do people actually need to hear? Why?	In your "SonLight Circle," pray for opportunities to preach God's word, and to find the people that need to hear it most. Share prayer requests from the last question and pray over each other.
