



The Confident Life

Week Eight Titus 3:1-8

This week we are looking at Titus 3:1-8. This passage is about living with confidence in Jesus. We have been saved from much and don't, in any way, deserve the blessing of eternal life. But God stepped into our world, and sent Jesus as our payment for sin. We are now heirs with eternal destiny that is the same destiny as Jesus. We are loved with an eternal love, we repent of our sin because of the kindness of God, and because of his mercy we are saved from spiritual death.

Making it personal...

Which observation(s) from Sunday's sermon do you feel the need to apply to your life?

How has reflecting on these verses changed the way you think and feel about God today?

How would you explain the kindness and mercy of God to someone who is not following Jesus?

From the sermon, of the first four points (Submit Obediently, Serve Eagerly, Speak Gently, Show Humility) which one do you want to get better at? Why? What steps can you take to grow in that?

How can you be "set apart" (holy) and serve all people without coming off as "holier than thou" or even thinking you are superior?

When you consider your former way of life, does it make you sad, angry, or depressed? Does taking time to remember your past help you to better appreciate the difference Jesus has made in your life? How so?

What characteristics of God moved him to save you? Which one do you need the most right now?

What gifts of eternal life do we already enjoy? What blessings of eternal life are we assured we will have in the future? How do we become heirs to eternal life?

What makes you most confident in God? Why?

In your "SonLight Circle," pray for opportunities to reflect on what God has saved you from and what he has saved you to. Share prayer requests from the last question and pray over each other.
