# Life Group Study Guide

**Everyone Has Something to Give Mark 12:41-44; Romans 12:3-8** 

For the Week of November 18th, 2018

- 1. What insight, principle, or observation from this weekend's message did you find to be the most helpful, eye-opening, or troubling?
- 2. When you were younger, when was the first time you remember doing something in a group or team? How did you have to work together to accomplish what you were trying to do?
- 3. When you were younger, did you struggle to share your stuff? Why or why not?
- 4. When you think about generosity, is it scary to be like the widow in Mark 12:41-44? Why or why not? What does generosity like the widow require?
- 5. What does it mean to contribute out of "their abundance" (see Mark 12:44)? What does it mean that the widow contributed "out of her poverty"?
- 6. Is it hard for you to think about yourself as God sees you (see Romans 12:3)? Why or why not? Why is it so hard to have "sober judgement" about ourselves?
- 7. As Paul talks about the church, what does "in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function" mean? (see Romans 12:4)
- 8. God has given everyone a function in the church. What do you think yours is? How can this group help you fulfill your function?
- 9. What are the gifts God has given you? How are you using them?
- 10. Spend time asking God to give wisdom to the group and you individually, and pray for opportunities to act on what you are learning about transformational generosity.
